

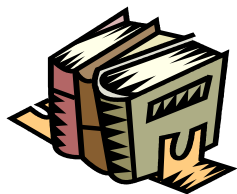
About the Morrill Memorial Library

Norwood's first library started when Rev. Jabez Chickering loaned his 95-book collection to his parishioners. Many book contributions later, in 1873, Francis Tinker became Norwood's first librarian, concurrent with Norwood becoming incorporated as a town.

The library building, dedicated in 1898, was a gift to the town from a wealthy businessman and his wife, George and Louisa Morrill in memory of the passing of their daughter Sara Bond from typhoid fever in 1895. The building has been renovated three times since then.

Today's library is a beautiful, modernized space that serves 200,000 visitors per year!

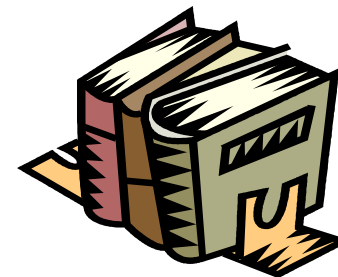
